I would like to invite you to please attend a Lodge meeting soon. Speaking of dues renewal, as I advised in the last issue of the Horn, the fees that you pay to Grand Lodge have increased so that your remittance for 2024-2025 Lodge year will be: \$86.25 for Life Members & \$136.25 for newer Members. As I have previously requested; please include a filled-out due's renewal coupon with your payment, so that I have current info. Please pay your "dues" soon to make my life a little easier and to ensure that you have your new card by April 1st, when the card reader will be changed. 


